Registration Fee

Participation in the Course requires registration that can be entered through the Registration Form which can be downloaded at the webpage: www.unimib.org clicking on IVEC. On the Registration Form all the modalities for payment are indicated.

- **€500.00 (+VAT 20%)** – 10% additional cost for registrations entered after the 30th September 2010.

There will be free registration for Trainees in Cardiology, Radiology, Cardiac and Vascular Surgery (a letter from the Directors of the Training Programmes is required) including the members of European Association of Vascular Surgeons in Training – EAVST. The ISVS Members will be granted a 20% discount.

The registration fee includes:

Scientific Presentations

Each paper will be allotted **8 minutes**. Should the presentation be shorter than 8 minutes, the remaining allotted time will be dedicated to discussion concerning the single presentation. A general discussion will be held at the end of each Session. Discussion will be open by the selected Discussant.

Call for Abstract and Abstract Submission

Presentation of Free Papers will be included in addition to the Sessions with Invited Faculty. All participants are kindly invited to present their research findings and experience on vascular and endovascular topics by submitting abstracts. A Joint Selection Committee constituted by an Officer of the ISVS, the President of the SICVE - Società Italiana di Chirurgia Vascolare ed Endovascolare, the President of the College of the Italian Professors of Vascular Surgery, the President of the College of the Italian Chiefs of Vascular Units, will select the best papers from those submitted and will be prized during the awarding Ceremony on Saturday, 23rd October at the closure of the Congress. Authors of accepted papers will be entitled to a reduction of 50% on the Registration Fee to attend the congress (€300,00 VAT included). Abstracts should be submitted electronically to: ivec@unimib.org. Please limit your Abstract to approximately 300 words. The **deadline** for the submission of Abstracts is **Tuesday 20th July 2010** and Authors will be informed of the outcome by the end of July.

Twenty to 30 posters will be selected by a distinguished panel of judges to be viewed throughout the IVEC/ISVS Joint Congress. The Poster session will open at 08.30 on Friday the 22nd of October and will close at 16.00 hours same day in the Conference Area of the Melià Hotel in Milan. Our panel of judges will select the three best awards based on the posters and a three minute presentation. Cash prizes for 1st (\$1,000) 2nd (\$500) and 3rd (\$300) place will be awarded at the awarding ceremony scheduled for Saturday the 23rd at the closure of the Congress. You must be present at the awarding ceremony to accept your award. Authors of accepted abstracts will be entitled to a reduction of 50% on the Registration Fee to attend the congress (€300,00 VAT included) or to a discounted fee of €150,00 if attending the Congress only for the day of Friday. Photographs will be taken with the panel of judges and posted on the ISVS web site. An ISVS certificate will be mailed to you.
